



2017 Goals and Priorities

1. Serve Myanmar Institute of Theology (MIT) for one semester as Visiting Professor in New Testament and Christian Spirituality.
2. Expand Myanmar ministries outside of MIT by
 - a. providing *Spirit-Led Leader* and *Spirit-Led Living* workshops for Christian leaders (Kachin State and elsewhere),
 - b. teaching indigenous Burmese missionaries,
 - c. establishing additional partners in Christian leadership development, and
 - d. preaching occasionally at the New Life International Fellowship church for expatriates.
3. Conduct one workshop for the Association for Theological Education in Myanmar (ATEM) member faculties.
4. Conduct *Spirit-Led Living* workshops in Vietnam and Cambodia
5. Conduct *Spirit-Led Leader* workshop in Ukraine.
6. Publish, promote and distribute *Saying "Yes" to God: How to Keep in Step with the Spirit* in the USA and Myanmar.
7. Expand research staff and conduct extensive survey on spirituality among Christian leaders in Myanmar.
8. Provide teaching in various strategic contexts in the United States on Spirit-led leadership and spiritual vitality.
