



2018 Ministry Goals

1. Continue to serve at Myanmar Institute of Theology (MIT) as a visiting Professor in New Testament & Christian Spirituality, as a spiritual life coach and as a spiritual and academic resource person on campus.
2. Develop a new elective course, "Paul: The Teacher Who Changed the World."
3. Lay the groundwork for a new Spirituality and Counseling Center at MIT.
4. Discern the right balance among various priorities:
 - a. Teaching, leadership development, and ministry- on and off MIT campus.
 - b. New Testament teaching versus Pastoral Theology and spirituality.
5. Conduct and expand Myanmar ministries outside of MIT.
6. Identify potential candidates to serve as future program staff in Myanmar with an eye to long term FHLGM program development. Create and experiment with providing various leadership development opportunities for promising candidates.
7. Experiment with inviting a volunteer professor to teach pastors in Vietnam under the auspices of FHLGM.
8. Continue promoting and teaching on *Saying Yes to God: How to Keep in Step with the Spirit*.
 - a. Seek more venues to teach on the book to CPC small groups.
 - b. Find a suitable translator to begin work on translating the book into Burmese.
9. Expand the financial and prayer support base for FHLGM.
