



2019 Ministry Goals and Priorities

1. Continue to serve at Myanmar Institute of Theology (MIT) as a Visiting Professor in New Testament & Christian Spirituality, as a spiritual director for students, and as a spiritual and academic resource person on campus
2. Finish digitally recording and editing all NT Theology (NTT) lectures as a resource for others in Myanmar who will be teaching NTT at MIT (in my place) or elsewhere in the country
3. Conduct several Spirit-led Leadership workshops outside of MIT in collaboration with Myanmar Baptist Convention (MBC) and other partners in Myanmar
4. Hire full time Program Assistant and groom to serve as increasingly capable second program staff member in Myanmar
5. Continue translation initiatives to provide more of Tim's books and teaching materials into local languages in Myanmar (e.g., Burmese, Karen, and Chin)
6. Seek additional volunteer, adjunct professors to teach pastors in various locations globally under the auspices of FHLGM (e.g., in Vietnam, Rwanda, Myanmar)
7. Serve as resource person in some yet-to-be determined capacity to Christ Presbyterian Church staff during transition period between pastors
8. Continue promoting and teaching on *Saying Yes to God: How to Keep in Step with the Spirit* in the United States
